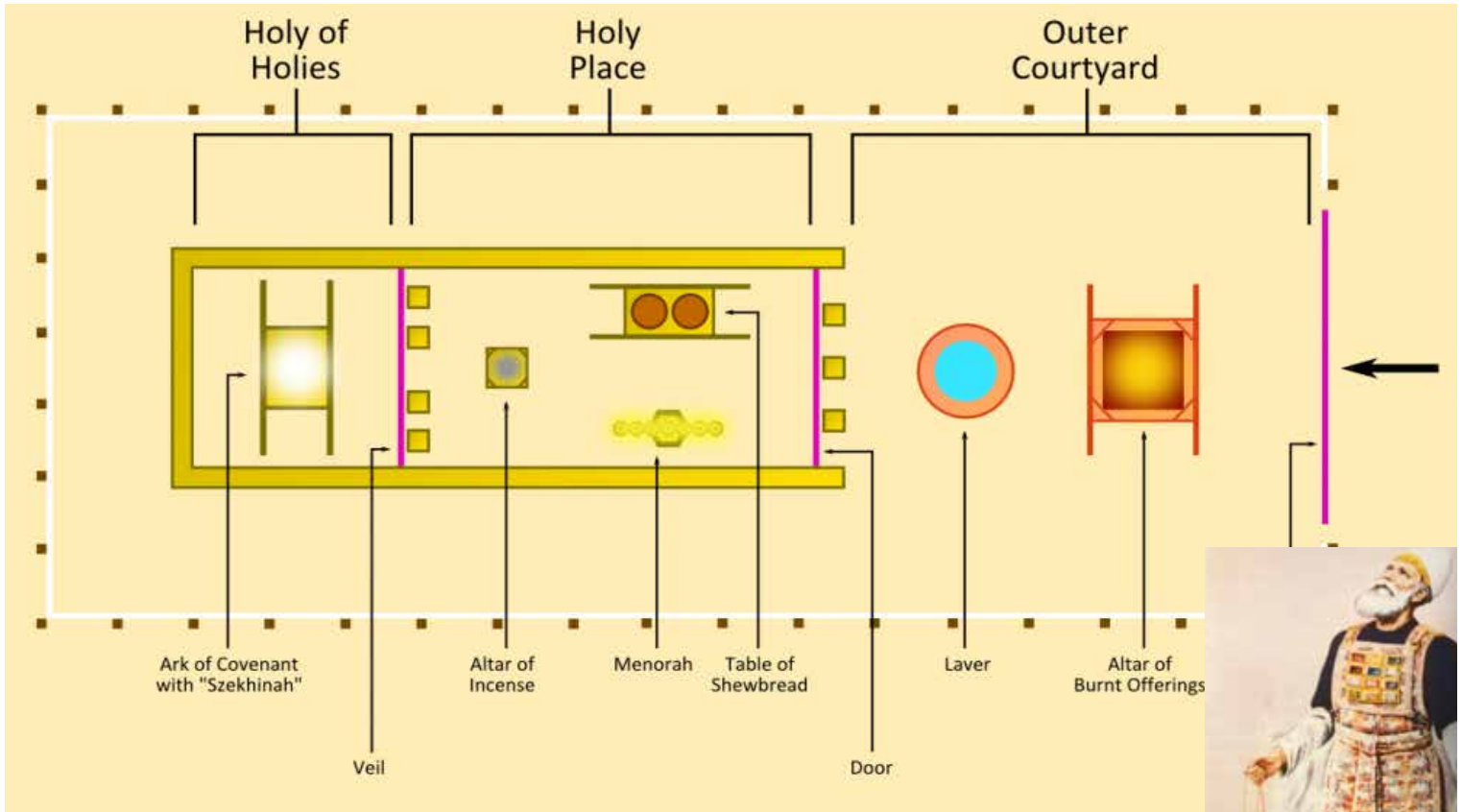

Jesus in Exodus

How is Christ our passover? (Exodus 12, 1 Corinthians 5:7)

Use sanctified imagination to consider how tabernacle, priesthood, ark of the covenant, mercy seat, and pillars of fire & cloud point towards Jesus Christ

Exodus Recalled in the 4 Gospels

Matthew 2:15 "Out of Egypt I called my son" (see Hosea 11:1 and Exodus 4:21-23)

Matthew 1:21 "Immanuel" = "God with Us," (Exodus 40:34-38)

Matthew 27:51 Temple Curtain Torn - Tabernacle and Temple replaced now by Jesus.

John 1:14 "The Word became flesh and **tabernacled** (dwelt) among us, and we have seen his **glory**, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. (see Exodus 40:34-38)

John 1:29, 36 "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (Exodus 12)

Matthew 26:17-30, Mark 14:12-25, Luke 22:7-22:23: Last Passover & First Lord's Supper
