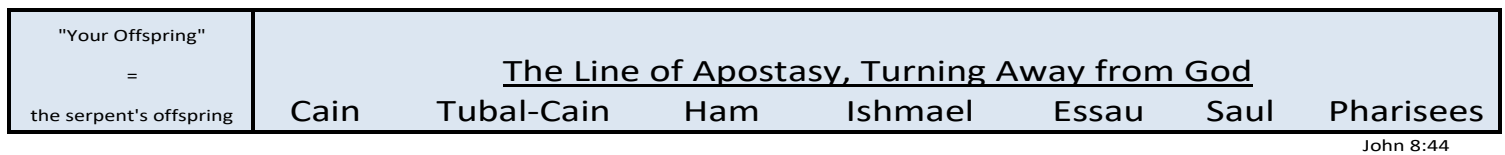
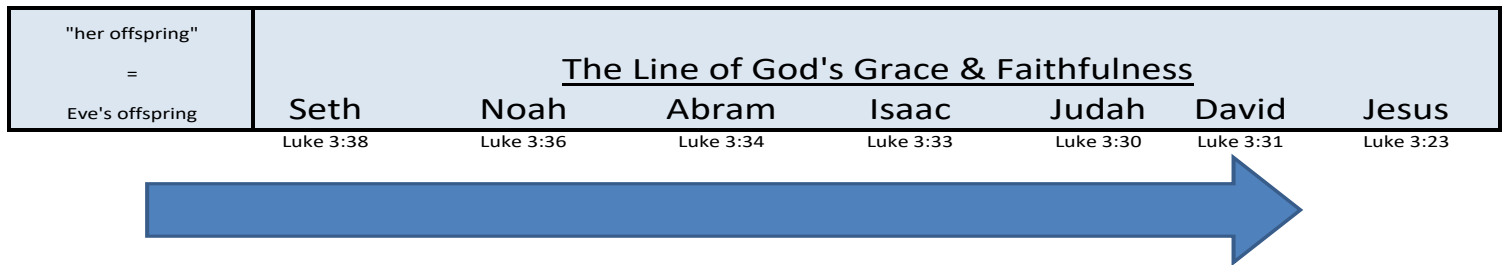
Genesis 50:20 Summarizes the Whole Bible "You meant evil...God meant it for good"

Genesis 3:15 "The Proto-Evangelium" = ProtoType Gospel = First "Good News" from God:

"I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

The Proto Evangelium, Genesis 3:15, is the prophecy that predicts the entire Bible

"...your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head; and you shall bruise his heel."



Genesis 3:21 Proto substitutionary sacrifice for sin: God's animal skins cover Adam & Eve
"the LORD God made for Adam and for his wife garments of skins and clothed them"
