**Author: Probably Solomon** 

Theme: Life Under the Sun is Vanity (apart from God, all is vanity) - Ecclesiastes 1:2

hevel ('vanity') – occurs 38x, lit. means "a puff of wind" or "a breath of air" tachath hashamesh ("under the sun") – occurs 28x

VANITY = ephemeral - short-lived, transient, fleeting, passing, brief, momentary, transitory, temporary

What is crooked cannot be made straight, and what is lacking cannot be counted.

- Ecclesiastes 1:15

Consider the work of God: who can make straight what he has made crooked?

- Ecclesiastes 7:13

As it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet, "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, **and the crooked shall become straight**, and the rough places shall become level ways, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God."

Authorship: Solomon; 'Agur' (30.1) and 'Lemuel' (31.1) either pen-names for Solomon or unknowns
Date: 970-686 BC (cf. 25.1: portions copied out by the men of Hezekiah, who reigned until 686)

• **Circumstances**: The golden age of the Solomonic kingdom (1Ki 4.29-34)

• Theme: "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction." (1.7)
